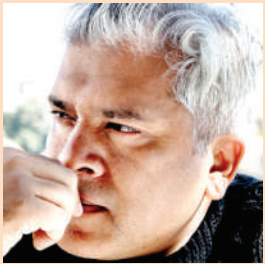

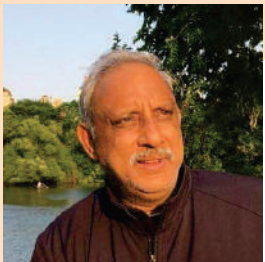
DANISH HUSAIN

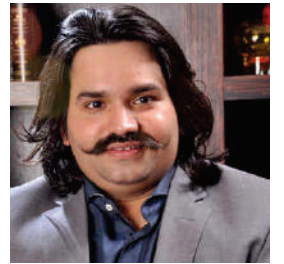
SAURABH SHUKLA

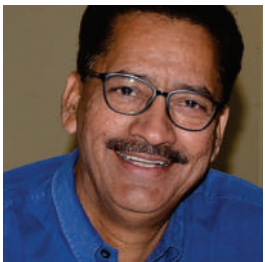
SUDHESH VYAS

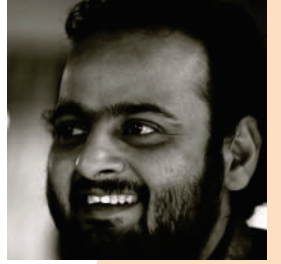
RAJENDRA PAYAL

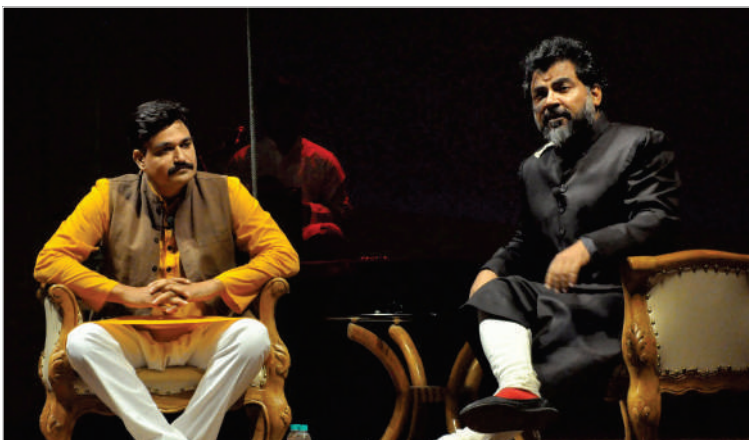
SARTAJ NARAIN MATHUR
