ATUL SATYA KUSHIK

An alumnus of Sri Ram College of Commerce, Delhi and is a qualified Chartered Accountant. He also holds a degree in Law. In his early 30s, he has already written 12 full length theatre plays and produced and directed 15 theatre productions with over 300 shows in different parts of India. He is often credited for pioneering modern commercial theatre in Delhi. His trademark productions include Legend of Ram, Chakravayuh, Raavan Ki Ramayan, Dad's Girlfriend, Lots of Love, Ballygunge 1990, Pajama Party, Draupadi, Kahani Teri Meri, Wo Lahore, Couple Trouble etc.

SAURABH SHRIVASTAVA

Saurabh Srivastava was born in Varanasi in 1963. His early involvement with theatre began as a humanities undergrad in Allahabad University in 1980, where he worked simultaneously as actor/director/co-director with groups called Campus Theatre and the Muir Dramatic Society, putting up several productions with each: Kasturi Mrig, Mukhyamantri, Elkaar, Mahabhoj, Bichchhoo (Moliere's Les Fourberies de Scapin), Baap Re Baap, Chor Ke Ghar Mor (Ben Jonson's Volpone), Ankh Se Nikli Roshni etc. His passion for theatre was also augmented by his study of English and Sanskrit literature, both of which were among his undergrad courses and he has adapted several short stories by Prem Chand and Chekhov for the stage, directing and acting in Kafan, Poos Ki Rat and Girgit.



ANIKET PATIL

Aniket is a prominent director & writer. He has a profuse experience when it comes to marathi plays. His work is well recognized through

his gujrati and marathi play ovey. He is a versatile talent and his comedy play 10 by 10 proves it. He has been associated with creative teams of various reality shows. Currently he is doing a stint in web series. He is co-founder and co-owner of bespoke films which is a well known production house.

MAKARAND DESHPANDE

Makarand Deshpande has always been the ubiquitous, mind-stirring writer who has evoked the audience's feelings without treading on the down-trodden path of conveying a message. A brief chat with him post the play throws light on the true inspiration of the play. If a play or movie sets your mind ticking for answers, then the battle is won.



BHANU BHARTI

Bhanu Bharti (born 1947) is an eminent Indian theatre director and playwright, and the founder-director of Aaj Rangmandal theatre group. Most known for his theatre productions and choreographies with tribal and folk artists, including Pashu Gayatri by K.N. Panikkar, Kaal Katha and Amar Beej all based on rituals of the Bhil tribe of Mewar region of Rajasthan, apart from Chandrama Singh urf Chamku Das, Yamgatha and Aks-Tamasha, counting to over 70 plays in a career spanning nearly four decades.



PIYUSH MISHRA

Before his debut in Dil Se.. and his acclaimed movie Gulaal which made Piyush Mishra a household name, he was already a celebrated theatre actor and director. He has written and directed many successful plays in Delhi with his theatre group, ACT 1, after graduating from NSD. After a hiatus of 20 years, Mr. Mishra is back on stage holding the reins, as he directs his most popular musical 'Gagan Damama Bajyo'.



AKARSH KHURANA

One of the leading theatre producers in India, Akarsh Khurana has produced over 60 plays in the last 19 years of which he has directed over 20. Akarsh won the award for Best Director twice at Thespo (India's premier youth theatre festival) for his early work and went on to be nominated five times at a national level for Best Director (at the Mahindra Excellence in Theatre Awards) and won it once for Stage Design. He has also directed lots of web sketches, five cineplays, a television movie for Anurag Basu (Real FM), a web series for ALT Balaji (Boygiri), and two feature films including Karwaan, featuring Irfan Khan, Dulquer Salmaan, and internet sensation Mithila Palkar.



GOPAL ACHARYA

Actor, director, writer, painter and the Founder of Rasadhara Sansthan, he has been practising theater activism in villages and towns with theater partners on social and national concerns. He has improvised plays,

conducted theater workshops in tribal areas and cities with several voluntary organizations across the country. Equally active in poetry, story and play writing, puppet production, conception & direction of puppet plays He has written, directed and acted in about 50 plays. His famous plays include – Bhopa Bherunath, Butt Bandebanam pray kahani, Bachao Bachao.



SWATI DUBEY

Swati Dubey did her graduation in Microbiology and in Journalism. She completed her MBA in Rural Management from Gujarat. She has done a one year diploma course in theatre from Madhya Pradesh School of Drama.

She is a founder member of SamagamRangmandal & has acted in more than 40 plays. Her directed plays are Mitti Ki Gandhi, Metamorphism, Left Right Left & Agarbatti for which she was awarded for Best Director and Best Light Designer in the Mahindra Excellence Theater Award 2019.



DANISH IQBAL

Danish Iqbal is an awarded media professional playwright. He has hundreds of plays and documentaries to his credit. With his many well-crafted stage plays, he has contributed something new and meaningful, exciting and insightful to the present day theatre scene. Azhar, editor of only theatre magazine in Urdu RANG-RASA, is enriching Urdu literature by writing or translating plays in Urdu.
