Synopsis:

For this Girl of 25, life with Herself is continually turbulent. This morning is particularly overwhelming; She is assaulted by self-doubt, unemployment, too much social media, and her mother. Still, She must brave the mundanity and frivolousness of urban girlhood, all the while looking for someone to blame. This is the story of an ordinary day in Her life.

Director's Note:

If you've ever had a mundane fight with a parent about your future, if you've ever wanted to throw your phone in response to the absurdity of social media, if you've ever found yourself around people with nothing to talk about, and if you cannot seem to stop the endless, torturous chatter in your mind – this play is for you.

I Killed my Mother / It Wasn't my Fault is young, brash, and camp. It is beloved for its brutal awareness of angst, self-loathing, desperation to belong, and generational division. Infused with pop culture and multimedia, it bends genre by creating a comically absurd, and yet terrifyingly realistic dramatization of the mental chatter of a young 25 year old woman who loves her phone more than she loves her mother.
